DEFINITION: Cross and Wheel: Couples Hinge, As Couples Step and Fold.


Cross Trade and Wheel: Couples Hinge, Very Centers Trade, As Couples Step and Fold. Grand Cross Trade and Wheel: Couples Hinge, Triple Trade, As Couples Step and Fold.

Single Cross and Wheel: Hinge, Step and Fold.


Single Cross Trade and Wheel: Hinge, Centers Trade, Step and Fold. Grand Single Cross and Wheel: Hinge, Center 6 Step as the End 2 Fold.

Grand Single Cross Trade and Wheel: Hinge, Triple Trade, Center 6 Step as the End 2 Fold.




