

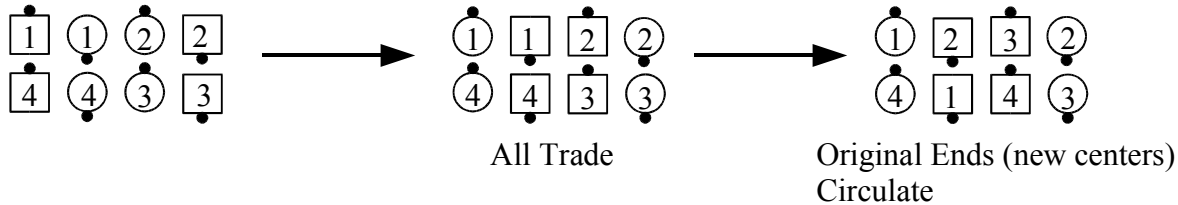

RIMS/HUBS TRADE BACK

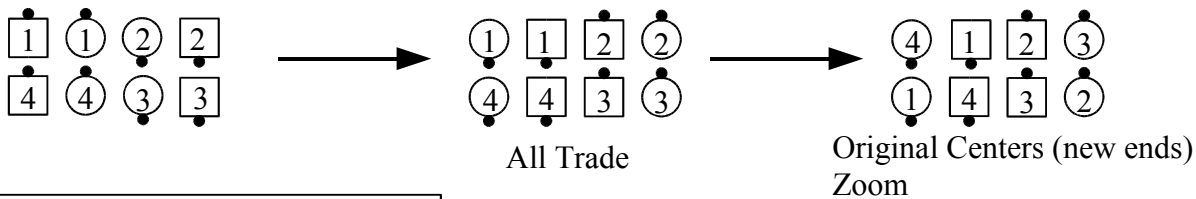
Welcome to Keith's Klass. This month we will look at Rims/Hubs Trade Back/<anything>. We will look at some unusual applications of this call that you have probably not seen on the dance floor.

DEFINITION: All Trade. Original Ends (for Rims) or Centers (for Hubs) Circulate, or do the <anything> call.

Hubs Trade Zoom from Two Faced Lines

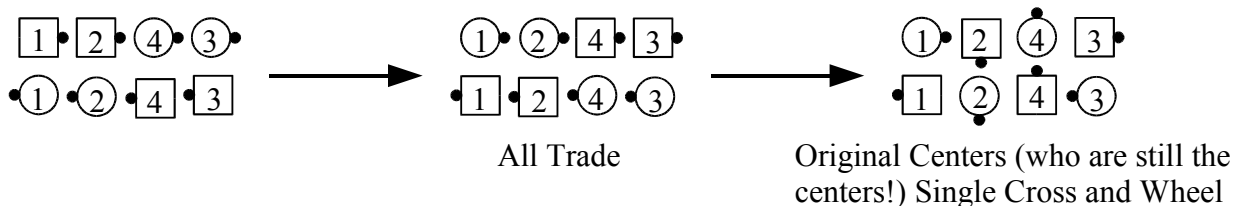


Rims Trade Shazam from a Tidal Line



It is generally accepted that the “Trade” should involve ends trading with centers, such as from lines or from a thar. If we disregard this and allow the call to start from columns, some very unusual things can happen.
