

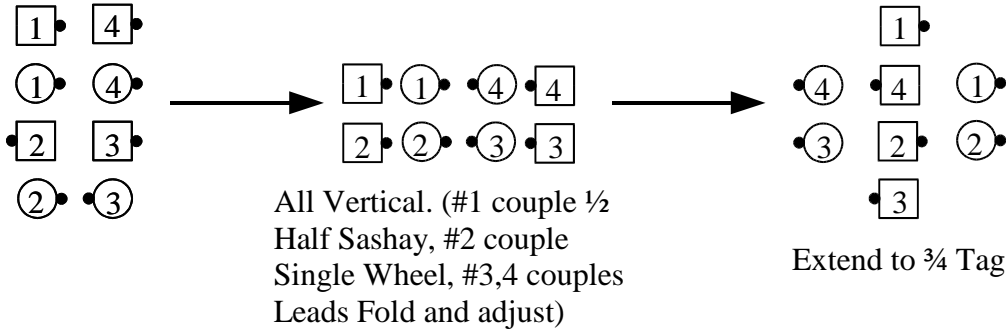

Vertical Tag/Vertical <anything>

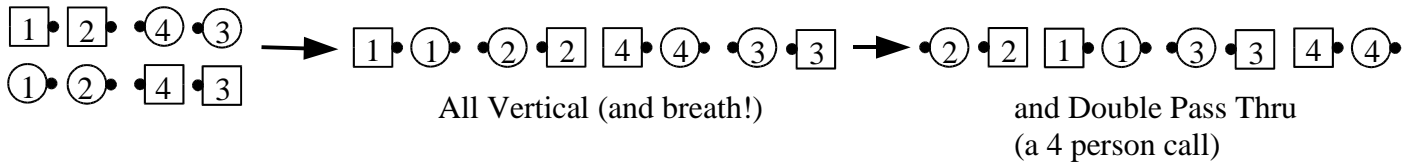
Welcome to Keith's Class. This month we will look at Vertical Tag/Vertical <anything>. "Vertical" changes a box of 4 into a single file column of 4 (facing tandems). Callers must be careful using Vertical with phantoms to avoid being bitten by the "ambiguity bug".

DEFINITION: First get Vertical. There are three ways to do this. Couples facing out of their box Single Wheel. Couples facing into their box do 1/2 of a Half Sashay (Single Shuffle, Belle on front of Beau). Mini Waves do a Leads Fold and adjust to a 1x4 column. Then Extend to the given fraction tag, or do the <anything> call.

Vertical 3/4 Tag

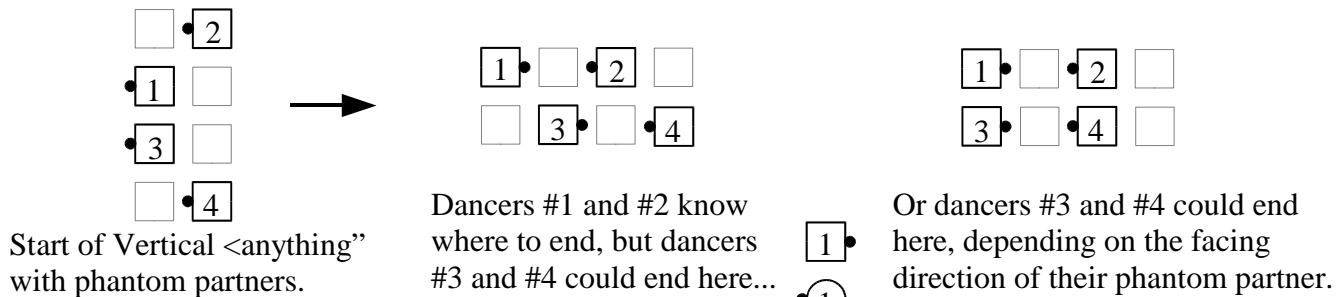


Vertical Double Pass Thru



When working with phantoms, some positions must be avoided. Lead Belles and Trailing Beaus cannot tell where to end up when doing a "Vertical" with a phantom partner because it depends on the facing direction of the phantom. Unless the caller gives a hint as to the facing direction of the phantom, the result is ambiguous.
